

## THE FULL CONTEXT OF THE GOSPEL

John 3:16	For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. (The is not the Gospel)
John 3:17	For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him (This verse raises two questions: 1) Why do we need to be saved? 2) What do we need to be saved from?)

Genesis 3:6	Rebellion (Sin) - The Fall

Romans 3:23	No one is Perfect - all have Sinned
Isaiah 59:2	We are Separated from God - NO HOPE!

2 Thessalonians 1:9	Punished with Everlasting Destruction
Revelation 14:11	No Rest Day or Night
Revelation 20:10	Lake of Fire and Brimstone, Tormented Day and Night Forever and Ever

Genesis 3:15	The first Promise of Victory and a Savior = Protoevangelium
John 3:16	The Promise fulfilled
1 Corinthians 15:3-4	The Core of the Gospel
2 Corinthians 7:10	Repent (Leads to Salvation)
Romans 6:23b	Salvation is a Free Gift
Ephesians 2:8-9	Grace Alone and not by our Works
2 Corinthians 12:9	God's Grace is Sufficient
Romans 5:8	God Demonstrates His Love by coming to us first
John 14:6	There is only One Way
Romans 1:19-20	No one has an Excuse for not believing
